School Programs Implemented...Life Launch University, School Pulse, PEP (Personal Empowerment Program.)	Facilitate Life Launch University. Every Monday Homeroom time will be dedicated to Life Launch messages. Specific Lesson topic/subjects will be selected by Counselors. Present School Pulse to students and distribute materials around school for students to sign up. PEP Group will be facilitated every Thursday.	Life Launch University teach many skills of resiliency and coping. How to deal with emotions when we get "Emotionally Hijacked". School Pulse is a program that works with students through text messaging. They receive a text rating how they are feeling and based on response are giving more specific information. Students are able to communicate with a person to talk through struggle through text messaging. Students are also given access to links where they can listen podcasts, read articles/stories and other information that will help them through their struggle. PEP- The PEP Program was developed to enhance student life skills for daily adolescent living, including communication, problem-solving, stress reduction, and coping skills. The group program will take place once per week for half of one class period during the school day. A Prevention Specialist from the Southwest Behavioral Health Center Prevention Services facilitates the program. The purpose of this program is to provide support and education, not therapy, although what students discuss in this program will be confidential.		\$0.00	Select a program
